

LARNED RETAINS TITLE Tennis Champion Disposes of Clothier at Newport.

FIVE SETS ARE REQUIRED Winner Takes First Two and Last, the Scores Being 6-1, 6-3, 5-7, 1-6, and 6-1—Has Won Championship Five Times—Clothier Is Decidedly Off in His Playing.

Newport, R. I., Aug. 27.—The title of States lawn tennis champion, which has been held since the summer of 1907 by William J. Clothier, was today defended by the victor of the twenty-ninth annual all-continent tournament on the Newport Casino courts.

Winn took the first two sets and the last, the scores being 6-1, 6-3, 5-7, 1-6, and 6-1. This is his fifth victory in his long career on the all-continent courts and the third time in a row that he has won the championship. This puts his record at 22 wins and 10 losses.
